Meet at Matsue Regional Government Building at 8:50am

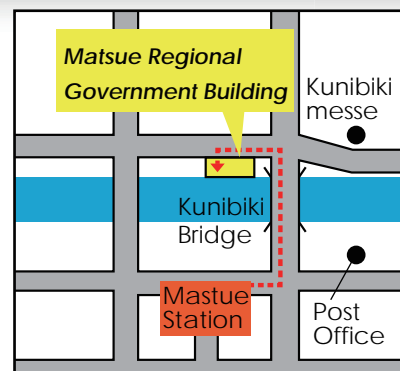
(Mukojima-cho 134-10, Matsue-shi, Shimane) 10 minutes walk from Matsue station

Lake Shinji is designated as "Wetland of International Importance" . It is home to numerous migratory birds. Especially, one of the largest wintering spot for ducks and geese in Japan.



You can enjoy guided bird watching around there. You would find Tundra swans, Greater white-fronted Geese, which are designated as national natural treasure, and other migratory waterfowls.
