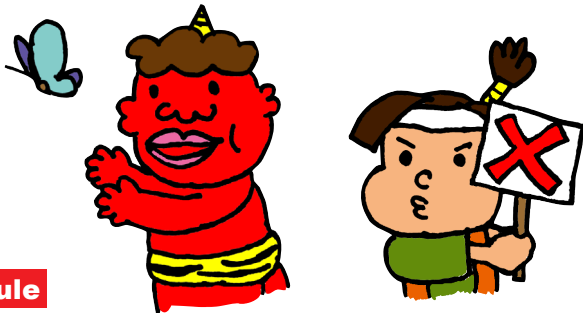

Rules & Manners in National Parks with



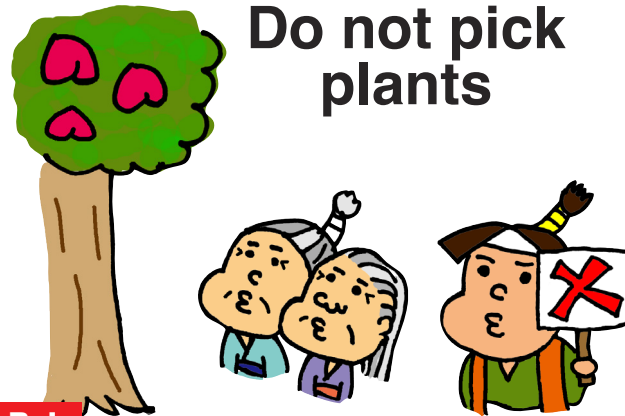
Do not capture any living creatures



Rule

Enjoy observing living creatures, but do not touch.

Do not pick plants



Rule

Enjoy observing the beautiful flowers, but do not pick.

Do not paint graffiti



Rule

Do not paint graffiti on, or otherwise damage facilities or signboards.

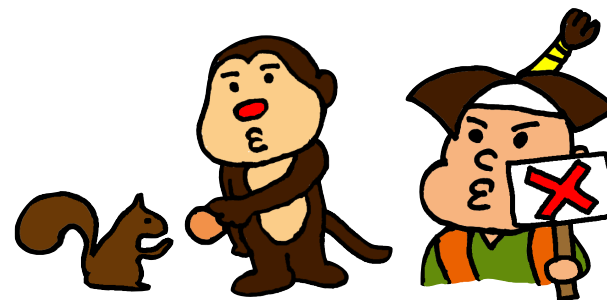
Sources of fire may be used only in designated areas



Rule

Almost all fires are caused by humans. Take every precaution when using sources of fire since fires can cause irreparable damage.

Do not feed the wild animals



Manner

Do not feed any wild animals you may encounter.

Stay on the designated paths



Manner

You may lose your way or tread on rare plants if you leave the designated paths.
